CALL FOR PAPERS


Catechesis is a perennial mission in the life of the Church, taking various forms across social and cultural contexts. In the Philippines, the Catholic faith has been rooted deeply in the lives of the people and has become both a tool for navigating Christian life in contentious times. The expression of faith in Christ Jesus, which is the definitive aim of catechesis, is also lived out in ways which reflect contemporary historical realities and the Filipino Catholics' identity in relation to the local and global Church. Given the current social environment, the task of catechesis remains vibrant and positively challenging.

On June 25, 2020, the Pontifical Council for the Promotion of the New Evangelization launched the latest edition of the Directory for Catechesis. The new edition, which is a dynamic continuity of the ones released in 1971 and 1997, provides new perspectives for the reinvigorated faith formation of the baptized.

Mystagogia, a biannual online journal of evangelization, catechesis, and religious education calls for the submission of papers for its inaugural issue. Mystagogia is a journal intended to address both academic and pastoral needs of the catechists and religious educators in Asia, especially the Philippines. This first issue will feature papers regarding:

- Catechesis and the New Evangelization
- Contemporary Religious Education
- Youth Ministry

Articles related to these topics will be welcomed for the maiden issue which will be released by the National Catechetical Month in September 2022. Subsequent issues will be released biannually (Advent and Easter). Submission should be in Turabian Style format and should contain at most 5000 words (including footnotes). Kindly include the abstract of the article in 150-200 words, and 5-7 keywords.
